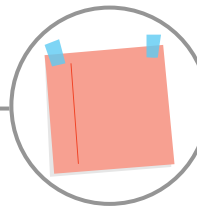

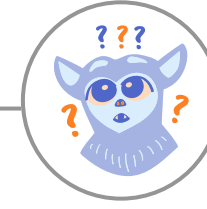
Because some days it's a logic model, and other days it's just a lot of feelings.

How are you feeling?



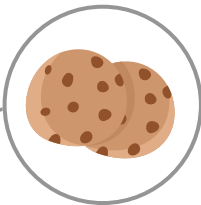
Hanging On By a Logic Model

Everything is a little unclear but technically exists in a table somewhere.



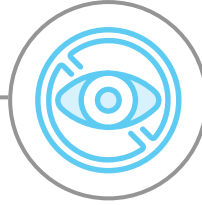
Just Tell Me What To Write

Staring at a blank report and hoping it fills itself in through willpower.



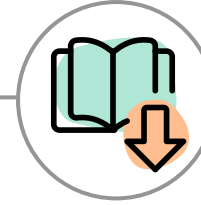
Send Help. Or Snacks.

Excel just crashed and so did my spirit. I accept cookies—both digital and real.



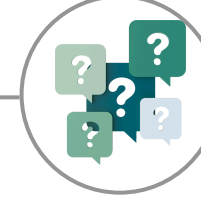
Avoiding Eye Contact With The Funder

That's how much I don't want to analyze this data right now.



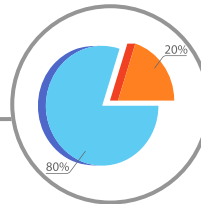
Asking the Big Questions

I don't totally know what I'm doing, but I've color-coded something, and it feels right.



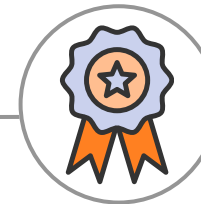
We're Tracking... Something
